COURSE OVERVIEW

This course aims to build meaningful connections and cultivate a sense of belonging for medical educators through lecture-based and small group discussions. Successful ways of engaging with learners, teaching mentors to be coaches, and ways to mitigate burnout by rediscovering happiness, joy, gratitude, and value in teaching and medical education is covered in this work-life integrated activity.
